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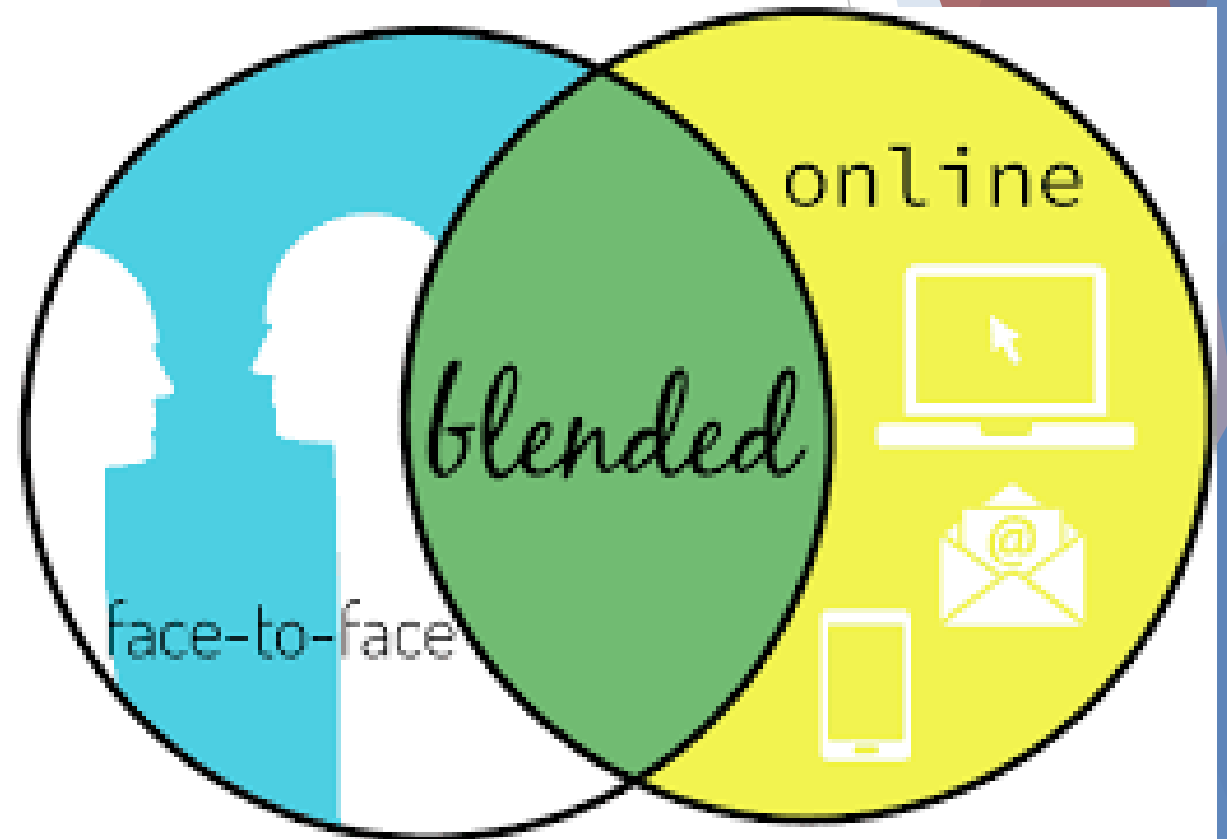
Role of Technology in Education

- ▶ “Technology” (like any tool) should only be utilized when it is appropriate to the situation at hand. The term “**instructional technology**” has **changed significantly** recently, describing any tool that is used to enhance learning
- ▶ By this definition, even the **textbook** was, at one point, a “technology” available to students and teachers. Technology does **not replace good teaching**, however. While a textbook contains all the information that might appear on an exam, a teacher can’t simply assign the reading of a textbook and expect a good outcome on the test.



Blended Instruction

“Blended Instruction” is a term that describes the incorporation of online-based instructional tools into the face-to-face instructional environment, creating a “blend” of online and offline instructional strategies

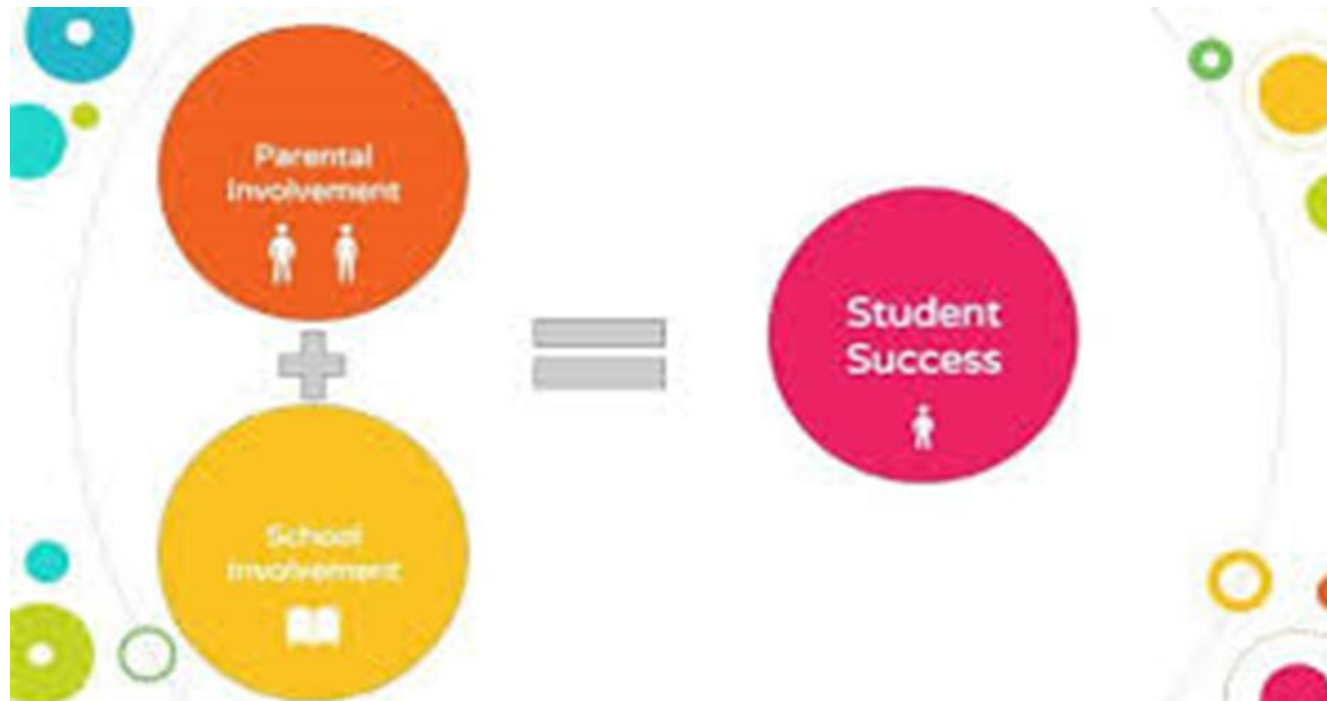
Technology : “Force multiplier” for Teacher

- ▶ Instead of the teacher being the **only source of help** in a classroom, students can access web sites, online tutorials, and more to assist them. Education doesn't stop at the end of the school day because students have access to teachers, resources, and assignments via the web and access these resources at any time. Students can also get help and tutoring at **any time**, whether from the teacher via email or online collaboration, or from a help web site.



Parental involvement: Increase student achievement

Most parents these days have extremely **busy** schedules, work different hours, and can't always help their child with homework or come to school for conferences. Technology can help. Parents can go to a class website and see what their child is working on, they can contact teachers via email and web sites, and they can even check their child's **attendance and grades** through **online systems**. They can also talk to their children from work via **email and instant messaging**.



Inquiry based projects :Get students to think rather than memorize

build important skills such as **communications, team work, critical thinking and problem solving. Technology can help** with these projects and skills. Students can create things such as **web sites, blogs, and multimedia presentations** as part of their project. They can use the web for research and as a **resource**. They can connect with students at other schools and do collaborative work with them. They also **learn technology skills while doing these projects.**



Money is an issue in education: Technology can help

- ▶ Virtual field trips, electronic forms instead of **paper**, **email** instead of printed memo's, **virtual labs**, **electronic textbooks**, and the thousands of **free online resources** can all save schools money and give students excellent educational experiences.
- ▶ Teachers can use technology to find resources and attend virtual professional development **seminars and conferences (most are free)**. They can also create personal learning networks (PLN) with Ning, Twitter, and other resources to find and share ideas and resources, and get support from their colleagues.

Current Findings

Current Findings

- ▶ 6. **Language is dynamic** not static it should be used with **updating knowledge**.
- ▶ 7. Whenever the **learners get a time**, he should expose himself to **speak only in English**.
- ▶ 8. **Encouraging group work and group learning** enhances the students' participation in learning language.



8 steps of systematic process in language teaching and learning

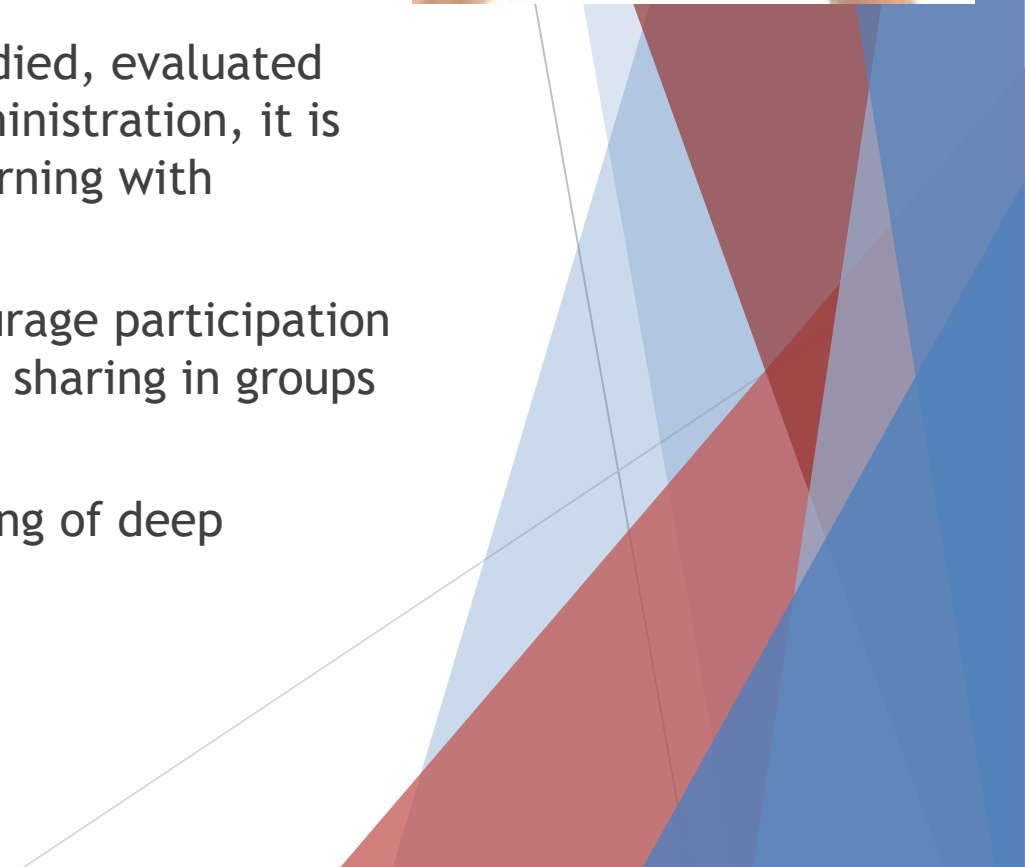
Systematic steps of language teaching and learning would enhance students' capacity and accelerate language learning. The 8 steps are:

- ▶ (i) proper lesson plan,
- ▶ (ii) interesting set induction,
- ▶ (iii) lesson message with
- ▶ (iv) constructive responses,
- ▶ (v) group discussion,
- ▶ (vi) correction and additional input from teacher,
- ▶ (vii) assessment on teaching outcome, and (viii) conclusion/homework.



4 pedagogical factors in its implementation

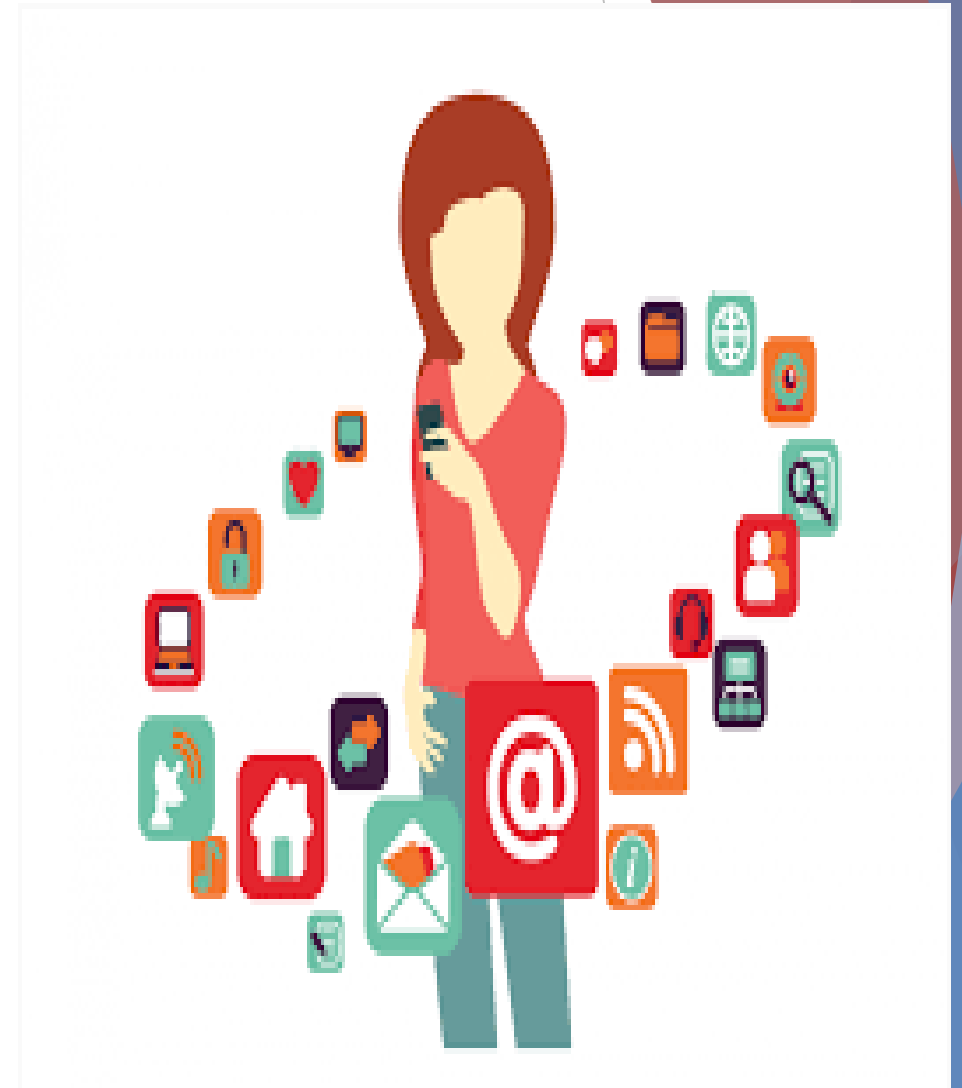
- (i) creativity: to have the ability to produce, innovate and improve, it is a commitment to transference new knowledge and generates new ideas
- (ii) reflectivity: the system implemented should always be studied, evaluated and improved in terms of teaching, learning and school administration, it is the awareness of teachers in synchronized teaching and learning with students learning styles
- (iii) reciprocity: giving, taking and co-operating, teachers encourage participation among teammates in a collaborative way. Peer learning and sharing in groups will enhance self-directedness and value teammate's
- (iv) responsible: one's success would be achieved with the feeling of deep responsibility as in Sunnah of the Prophet SAW.
